1 NIDAROSDOMEN NIDAROS CATHEDRAL

The world's northernmost gothic cathedral. Built from 1070 onwards over the tomb of St. Olav, the Viking King who brought Christianity to Norway, the cathedral was completed around 1300. In the summer you can climb the tower. The 172 steps to the top are dark and narrow, but the climb is well worth it. Once at the top, you can enjoy an unrivalled view of the city centre.



2 RIKSREGALJENE - THE CROWN REGALIA

The Crown of Norway is on exhibit at the Archbishop's Palace together with the Norwegian state regalia and crown jewels. The king's crown was made for the coronation of King Charles III John in 1818.



2 ERKEBISPEGÅRDEN - THE ARCHBISHOP'S PALACE MUSEUM

The pre-reformation home and administrative centre of the Norwegian Archbishops. In 1983 a fire destroyed two large wooden buildings in the Archbishop's palace. A new museum was erected in their place, housing many of the most spectacular finds from the archaeological excavations on the site. Here you'll also find the remains of the Archbishop's mint.



2 RUSTAMMERET - THE ARMOURY & RESISTANCE MUSEUM

The Armoury tells the history of the Norwegian armed forces from the Viking ages to the modern day, focusing on the equipment, arms and uniforms used by soldiers. The Resistance Museum relates events and stories from occupied Central Norway during WWII.



3 STIFTSGÅRDEN - THE ROYAL RESIDENCE

Stiftsgården is the royal residence in Trondheim, and the largest wooden mansion in Scandinavia, with 140 rooms and 4000 m². The mansion was originally built as a private residence in 1774-78.



39 MUNKHOLMEN

In ancient times a place for executions, the island has also housed a monastery, a fortress and a prison. Today a popular place for outings, and there is swim or visit the restaurant. Hourly tours of the fortress and open café when the island is served by ferry.



13 GAMLE BYBRU

THE OLD TOWN BRIDGE
The first bridge here was built in 1681, to provide easy access from the city to Kristiansen Fortress. The current bridge was designed by Carl Adolph Dahl, and erected in 1861. It is known to locals as "The portal of joy".



14 BRYGGJENE - THE WHARVES

The oldest of the wharves and storehouses lining the river as it passes through the city were built in the 1700s. They appear today much as they did then. The wharves facing seawards are of slightly more recent construction. Most were erected during the 18- and 1900s.



7 MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY AND ARCHAEOLOGY - NTNU University Museum
Exhibits on natural history, archaeology and cultural history. Great exhibition brings the medieval city Trondheim to life with rich finds from excavations. Café and museum shop with a wide range of souvenirs.



17 RINGVE MUSIKKMUSEUM - RINGVE MUSIC MUSEUM. MST

Ringve Music Museum is Norway's national museum for music and musical instruments, with a collection of over 2000 instruments from around the world. The museum is seated on an old country estate just outside Trondheim's city center, and is surrounded by the beautiful Ringve Botanical Garden. Join one of our musical tours or explore the museum on your own.



19 SVERRESBORG, TRONDLAG FOLKEMUSEUM

TRONDLAG FOLK MUSEUM. MST
In and around the ruins of King Sverre's medieval castle, you'll find one of Norway's largest open air museums, with a stave church and farms from all over Trøndelag.



40 MUSEET KYSTENS ARV. MST

Museet Kystens Arv is a coastal heritage museum on the Norwegian west coast. Norway's long and rugged coast, combined with our fjords, mountains and cold climate, meant that the sea, from the Stone Age and up to the mid 1900s was both the national highway and a main food source on the coast.



5 TRONDHEIM KUNSTMUSEUM - MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS. MST
Trondheim Kunstmuseum has a considerable collection of Norwegian and international art. On display is a selection of works from the collection, alongside temporary contemporary art exhibitions.



6 NORDENJELDSKE KUNSTINDUSTRIUMUSEUM NATIONAL MUSEUM OF DECORATIVE ARTS. MST

The national museum of decorative arts and design. The museum hosts 4-5 temporary exhibitions annually, in addition to permanent displays covering the period from the 15th century to the modern day.



4 TRONDHEIMENS SjøFARTSMUSEUM TRONDHEIM MARITIME MUSEUM. MST
Visit our family friendly museum and experience the history of Trondheim's trading tradition and sailing ship era from the 17th century and until today. Also watch our film about the training ship «Todenstjöld».



36 ROCKHEIM, MST

Rockheim is the national museum of popular music. In our spectacular museum you can experience Norwegian rock and pop music from the 1950s to the present day, with the aid of innovative technology and knowledgeable guides.



17 RINGVE BOTANISKE HAGE - RINGVE BOTANICAL GARDEN

A place where you can enjoy the colourful biodiversity of plants, and get to know more about trees, traditional medicinal plants, plant evolution and popular ornamental plants, among other things.



3 KRISTIANSTEN FESTNING - KRISTIANSTEN FORTRESS

The fortress was built after the great fire of 1681, and offers fantastic views of the city and its surroundings. During WWII the Nazi authorities executed members of the Norwegian resistance here. The fortress is open to the public, and you'll find an open café inside the fortress walls all year.



36 TRONDHEIMENS KUNSTFORENING TRONDHEIM ART SOCIETY

We are located in the old bishops house, with a nice garden including our café. You find art exhibitions in the café and in our gallery rooms on the second floor.
